CITY GOLF COURSE TO REOPEN SATURDAY WITH RESTRICTIONS

Strict guidelines must be observed by all patrons

The City of Fort Morgan will reopen the Quail Dunes Golf Course on Saturday, April 25, with numerous COVID-19 restrictions in place.

The Northeast Colorado Health Department has approved the reopening provided that golfers observe the following mandatory guidelines:

- Please book tee times in advance online at www.quaildunes.com or call 970-867-5991.
- Hole 16 will be closed for rehabilitation, and greens on holes 7 and 8 may have areas of ground under repair. Please stay off any juvenile plant growth on these greens.
- Maintain 6 feet of separation at all times while entering the golf shop.
- Guests **MUST** wear a face cover in/around the pro shop and when interacting with staff.
- **NO Cash!** Credit card purchases only and you will be asked to use a disposable glove or a tee to operate the PIN pad.
- Walking or single riding only in rental carts and privately owned carts, only immediate family members will be permitted to ride together. Privately owned carts must be licensed to be used at the Quail Dunes course.
- Due to a limited number of carts, there may not be a cart available at your tee time.
- Cups will be installed upside down eliminating the need to pull flags, or reach into the hole.
- Golfers are required to only touch their own equipment, balls, etc.
- Rental carts and pull carts will be sprayed down with disinfectant between groups.
- Restrooms on the course will be closed. Restrooms in the pro shop will be disinfected throughout the day and professionally cleaned each night.

- The pro shop and restroom doors will be propped open at all times.
- There will be separate entrance and exit doors for the clubhouse, please follow the directions indicated on the floor.
- The driving range will be closed and anyone using the putting green should maintain a strict 6 feet or more of separation.
- The restaurant area and patio will be closed.
- Scorecards and pencils will not be provided.
- Customers should bring their own hand sanitizer, disinfectant wipes, mask and any other personal protective equipment they feel necessary.

Failing to comply with these guidelines will result in being asked to leave the property. Any patron refusing to follow these guidelines or to leave the property will be reported to the authorities.
